# Program Updates

Behavioral Health Information Notice No: 25-010. BHIN (Behavioral Health Information Notices) are published by DHCS (Department of Health Care Services)\*

## Updates to:

- 1. Medi-Cal Peer Support Specialist Code of Ethics
- 2. Changes to Certification Certificates
  - o Counties Participating in Peer Certification Program listed
  - O Language that certify folks are older than 18+
- 3. Portability of Professional Licenses of Servicemembers and their Spouses

#### Renewals - New Statuses

- Current (Up to Expiration Date):
  - Certification is considered current if it is renewed on or before its renewal due date.
- Lapsed (Within 1 Year After Expiration):
  - Certification is considered lapsed if not renewed by the renewal due date but is still within one year
    of expiration period.
- Expired (Between 1–4 Years After Expiration):
  - Certification is considered expired if more than one year has passed since the renewal due date but less than four years.

#### Renewals - New Statuses continued

- Vacated (More Than 4 Years After Expiration):
  - Certification is considered vacated if not renewed within four years of the renewal date. To become
    certified again, individuals must satisfy certification requirements of taking the 80 hour Peer
    Certification training, passing the Exam, and reapply for a new certification.

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### California Correctional Health Care Services (CCHCS)

California Correctional Health Care Services (CCHCS) oversees a comprehensive training program to certify incarcerated individuals as Medi-Cal Peer Support Specialists while they are still in prison, preparing program participants for a career working with underserved populations post-release.

#### **DHCS No Cost Fee Waivers**

CalMHSA, in partnership with DHCS, is offering time-limited fee waivers to support the behavioral health workforce. Fee waivers must be used by September 15, 2025.

- Core Training (80-Hour Course) and Initial Certification: 400 fee waivers
  - Available to individuals seeking initial certification. Waivers toward certification are applied and will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Training in Areas of Specialization: fee waivers for training in one or more areas of specialization. Waivers are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Certification Renewals: 1,000 fee waivers are available and will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

#### Core Training (80-Hour Course) and Initial Certification

#### How it Works:

- 1. Interested individuals must contact the CalMHSA-approved training provider and register for an available open session.
- 2. Training provider will submit information for individuals who are registered for the approved 80-hour training to cover the cost of training.
- 3. Training must be started no later than September 15, 2025.
- 4. After successfully completing training, individuals will apply for certification on the CalMHSA website.



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## Training in Areas of Specialization

#### How it Works:

- 1. Must be a Certified Medi-Cal Peer Support Specialist.
- Interested individuals must contact the CalMHSA-approved Specialization training provider and register for an available open session (Parent, Caregiver, and Family Member Peer, Peer Services in Crisis Care, Peer Services for Unhoused, and/or Peer Services for Justice Involved).
- 3. Training must be started no later than September 15, 2025.
- 4. Training provider will submit information of individuals who are registered for an approved training to cover the cost of training.
- 5. After completing training, individuals are expected to return to their application to upload their training certificate(s) to be recognized for their specialized training.

#### **Certification Renewals**

#### How it Works:

- 1. Must be a Certified Medi-Cal Peer Support Specialist.
- 2. Must be eligible for renewal prior to September 30, 2025.
- 3. Individuals with expired certifications may qualify.
- 4. Individuals request the fee waiver directly through their certification application


