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Topic	Notes
Housekeeping	We reviewed the ways to raise your hand once called on, how to mute/un-mute yourself when dialed in by phone. We also provided information regarding Spanish interpretation and live transcripts. Also, we reminded everyone to use the Q&A feature so that their questions will be recording in the notes. We also gave everyone the reminder to speak for a maximum of one minute during public comment to ensure everyone has a chance to speak.
Roll Call	We asked the Stakeholder Advisory Council members to type in their name and county in the Zoom chat to indicate their attendance.
Meeting Agreements	As a group, we reviewed the meeting agreements that have been previously established – no changes were made.
CalMHSA Updates	California Mental Health Services Authority (CalMHSA) is putting together a FAQ and will be posting it to the CalMHSA website. CalMHSA will be releasing the Job Task Analysis (JTA) Survey next week once it is finalized.
Grandparenting Checklist	A council member asked if CalMHSA will accept pay stubs as a form of employment verification. Another council member questioned the two year in-person training requirement and raised concern for the COVID-19 pandemic that has been in effect the past two years. Council members stated they think the in-person requirements should have some leniency given the pandemic and most trainings have been taken online due to the pandemic. Another council member asked if there is a template for the letters of



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	<p>recommendation in order to save time drafting a letter incorrectly.</p>
<p>Study Guide Outline</p>	<p>A Stakeholder asked if California Mental Health Services Authority (CaIMHSA) will be providing sample study questions on the study guide. Another stakeholder stated that the study guide CaIMHSA put together contains more exam taking tips, opposed to sample questions that will help Peers pass the exam. A stakeholder stated that CaIMHSA can look at Rhode Island as an example for putting together a helpful study guide for the Peers community. Another council member asked where the 17 core competencies were housed within the study guide, the council member doesn't feel that the 17 core competencies aren't reflected in the study guide.</p>
<p>Public Comment</p>	<p>One of the council members asked when CaIMHSA can share the costs and fees associated with taking the exam. The public made a comment regarding the difference between the core competencies in the field vs. core competencies that are taught in Peer trainings. A concern was raised about the certifying exam testing peer support work versus conceptual peer support work. The public raised concern for Senate Bill 964 and what that means to Senate Bill 803 and inability to extend the grandparenting deadline. Another comment addressed a concern for core competencies for Supervisors and how they should differ for peers. The public also raised concern for parent partners who struggle with their Supervisor's directions and support for a family member. Another comment addressed a concern for Peers that have lived experience in the Foster Care system, who</p>



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	may not have the supporting documentation that is needed in order to be Grandparented in because of constant moving, the public wants to know how CaIMHSA will address those types of situations be addressed?
